

All students will be given opportunity to participate in a range of meaningful careers activities, introducing them to a wide range of careers, meeting with employers and further and higher education providers.

- An effective careers guidance programme has never been more important. Education, training and employment opportunities can be complex to navigate and are more challenging than ever before. The Tewkesbury Academy Careers Programme provides our students with the knowledge, inspiration and ability to manage their personal career plans in order for them to succeed in their chosen pathway.
- At each transition stage students will receive additional support and guidance from their Teachers, Tutors, our Careers Leader and the relevant Key Stage Teams and Heads of Year. Students are supported in making choices and decisions by giving access to impartial information and guidance as to the range of options available (including academic, vocational/technical pathways and apprenticeships).
- Our programme has been developed and mapped against the <u>Gatsby Benchmarks</u> and the latest <u>CDI</u> (Careers Development Institute) Framework.

Unifrog is an online careers information platform that helps students and teachers make decisions about postschool options. Designed to help students explore their interests, compare options, and apply for courses. Students can use Unifrog to:

- Discover career and subject-related video content
- Take quizzes and psychometric tests
- Compare universities, colleges, apprenticeships, and work experience opportunities
- Draft applications, such as CVs and personal statements
- Record achievements and activities

Students just need to login with their personal school email address as their login and click on "reset password" for a password link to be sent to their school email.


